



Guidelines for grant applicants for the development of Resilience Resource Center

General objectives

The Resilience Resource Centers should support:

1. The process of deinstitutionalization of care and services for children in Latvia and Moldova
2. The development of community-based services for children in alternative care and at high risk of exploitation
3. The provision of support for child victims of violence

Target groups

- ⌚ Professionals from the helping professions, working with children from specialized institutions, children at risk of institutionalization, children at risk and child victims of violence;
- ⌚ Parents of children from specialized institutions or children at risk of institutionalization, children at risk and child victims of violence; foster families;
- ⌚ Children in alternative care, children at risk, child victims of violence.

Who can apply?

- ⌚ NGOs registered under national law.

Funding, start date and duration:

- ⌚ The grant applied for cannot be more than **EUR 4345 /four thousand forty five euro/**.
- ⌚ The beneficiaries will sign a contract with Social Activities and Practices Institute, and within 30 days after the project completion will have to prepare a technical and financial report, together with copies of financial supporting documents.
- ⌚ The project implementation should be scheduled for a period of 12 months, starting September 1st 2014.

Social Activities and Practices Institute will support one project in Latvia and one in Moldova.

Possible types of activities

The following activities are eligible for funding:

- trainings for professionals and children
- workshops and other forms of group work with children and/ or families
- activities promoting the participation of children placed in residential institutions
- seminars, roundtables or work meetings, relating to deinstitutionalization, involving professionals, parents and children
- printed or electronic journals and publications relating to deinstitutionalization

All activities should be conceptualized through the resilience approach.

What type of activities are not eligible for funding?

- ⌚ Individual grants, scholarships, travels abroad
- ⌚ Initiatives of political, religious or trade union scope, as well as activities which are contrary to the principles of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child.

Award criteria:

- relevance (to what extent the project objectives, target groups and activities are consistent with the priorities of the call)
- efficacy (amount of funding with regards to the number of activities, number of participants, number of participating children)
- efficiency (what are the expected results)
- measurability of the results

Deadlines and list of required annexes:

The submitted project proposal should contain:

- ⌚ Annex 1 – Completed application form
- ⌚ Annex 2 - Justification of the project budget /free text/, up to 2 pages
- ⌚ Annex 3 – CVs of key members of the team implementing the project



- ⌚ Annex 4 – Copy of the latest legal registration of the organization
